Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Greenville Wastewater Treatment Plant Rehabilitation for Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Greenville located at 118 Court Street, Greenville, KY 42345. The funding would be used for a phase of construction of a new wastewater treatment plant. The new plant would upgrade their system to include new headworks with influent screening and a pump station, new oxidation ditches, new clarifiers, an upgraded system for disinfection, a new outfall lift station, a sludge dewatering rotary press, conversion of their existing aeration basins to equalization basins, and a new administrative and laboratory building.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the utility is under an agreed order from the state for exceeding their effluent limitations. These upgrades are necessary to ensure the wastewater treatment plant can treat biological influent and maintain compliance with their permit requirements, state regulations, and to ensure public health and safety.

This project has a federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized in Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
