
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for Metropolitan Sewer District Floyds Fork Wastewater System Rehabilitation in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Louisville Metropolitan Sewer District, responsible for the Floyds Fork watershed located at 1100 Blue Heron Rd, Louisville, KY 40245. This project would fund rehabilitation of the Floyds Fork watershed sewer collection system, including repair of gravity sewer pipe, manholes, property service connections, and removal of illicit private connections. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it prevents costly sanitary sewer overflows, basement backups, and roadway collapses, protects public health and local waterways, improves environmental quality, and ensures long-term reliability of wastewater infrastructure.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
